Carl Fowler, Dep Assessor, will be carrying out the State's requirements of visiting 20% of all properties starting this summer. He will be verifying what is on your property record card to ensure everything is correct. Please be kind to him, this is his job requirement. If you have an issue with a visit, or if you would like to request that no one visits your property, call 269-781-8422 let us know. Also, if you wish to measure your own buildings and give us the measurements, that is an option. We need to make sure you aren't being assessed for anything you don't currently have on your property.

Summer 2022. September 14th taxes are due and the office will be open 9:00-4:00. After that date each month there will be 1% monthly interest added to the amount owed. Make checks payable to: Marengo Township. Checks must clear or receipt is void. **No credit cards accepted.**

There is a green drop box on West side or black box in front of town hall. To request a receipt, enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope. Collections can be made in office on Fridays from 9-3.

If you qualify for Summer Tax Deferments the form is available in the office or contact the office and one will be mailed. Collections can be made in office on Fridays from 9-3. The last day to file for deferments Wednesday, September 14th, 2022, 9-4.
